5 Options for Health Care Coverage after UC SHIP

1. Stay on your parent’s group coverage until your 26th birthday when you are no longer eligible for this coverage .
2. Covered California Options.
3. Public Healthcare Programs.
4. UCLA Alumni Association health care programs.
5. UC SHIP Continuation Plan – extendable for one academic term after no longer a student.
