Online Travel Health Course

This course does not replace an in-person appointment with a travel health provider for necessary medications and immunizations.

Before you start the course:

- 1) Make sure that you have a printer in working condition with an adequate supply of paper.
- 2) Schedule one hour of uninterrupted time for this course.
- 3) Read instructions below.

Instructions:

- You are required to complete the online Travel Health Course and submit the Certificate of Completion form to UOEAP by the designated deadline.

- The course will take approximately 1 hour to complete. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Do not exit the course at any point before its completion as you cannot save your work and it will cause you to have to start the course from the beginning.
- Have access to a printer to **print 3 copies of your certificate at the end of the course.**
 - Mail one copy to UOEAP (address on certificate).
 - Bring one copy to your appointment with your Travel Health Provider.
 - Save one copy for your records
- After you complete the course, you must make an appointment with a travel health provider (at your campus Student Health Center, your private insurance provider or a local Travel Clinic), as soon as possible. During the in-person appointment, you will receive necessary vaccinations and medications before travel as **it is critical to consider vaccine-preventable diseases that may easily be caught during travel**, especially if you have a pre-existing medical condition. Also, if you will be traveling to a malaria-endemic region, you may need to take malaria chemoprophylaxis, in addition to taking mosquito avoidance measures.
